

Vocabulary for Talking about *To Kill a Mockingbird*

Radical Empathy Training 101

1.***Empathy (N.)** - The ability to understand and share the feelings of another; “to climb into [a person’s] skin and walk around in it” (Atticus Finch, chapter 3).

2.**Morality (N.)** - Principles concerning the distinction between right and wrong or good and bad behavior.

3.**Justice (N.)** - A concern for what is morally right and fair; a concern for peace and genuine respect for people.

4.**Ethics (N.)** - Moral principles that govern a person’s behavior or the conducting of an activity.
